If Swedish is not your first language, and you wish to learn the basics of Swedish, then SFI (Swedish For Immigrants) is the course for you. SFI studies are free of charge.

Purpose of the course

The purpose of SFI is for you to learn to speak, write, read and understand Swedish. You will be able to use your knowledge of Swedish in your day-to-day life; at work or in your further studies. During the course you will also learn about Sweden and the Swedish society.

SFI at Vaddö folk high school

This course is a cooperation between Norrtälje municipality and Vaddö folk high school. You will study three hours a day, **between 08.30 – 11.30**. Your class will consist of people with different experiences, life situations and knowledge. We will adjust the course to suit your and your classmates needs, interests and study goals. You will receive a grade after every sub-course, provided you have reached the sub-course goals and have passed the national exam. SFI has several study paths. Which path that is right for you de-pends on what study experience you have to begin with, and your previous knowledge of Swedish. Vaddö folk high school offers study path 2 and 3.

About Vaddö folk high school

Vaddö folk high school is a natural meeting place in Roslagen. People from all over the country study here and we have years of experience of education, integration and to adjust courses to suit participants needs. When studying at a folk high school you will be able to influence your education and you will establish connections and networks for life.

How to apply

You apply to the course through your municipality of residence.
